

The Video Room

1. A moderator should be chosen who at least has a working microphone. If mic doesn't work right away, select a moderator who has a working mic.
2. Moderators can use a webcam as well.
3. Please only turn on webcams when students have something specific to say or show related to the topic.
4. Moderator should coordinate timing of when everyone watches video. "On your mark, get ready...click play". If students are experiencing severe tech issues such as pausing, or can't view the video, please don't disrupt the rest of the class with your issues. Make a request to the teacher to change rooms.
5. Everyone try to watch the video at the same time from the YouTube video link located on the CurrClick resource page for that class week. Scroll down until you find the **class #** for that week. If there's more than one video, select the video your teacher assigns.
6. Write down interesting facts about the video in your journal.
7. After most everyone or everyone has finished watching the video, discuss the video.
8. Here are some suggested discussion items you can use after you've watched the video:
 - a) What new things did you learn from the video?
 - b) What facts did you already know?
 - c) What inspiration did you receive from the video?
 - d) What projects, activities or experiences would you like to do based on this video?
 - e) Other open discussions ideas the class wants to talk about regarding the video.
